- 1492 Trade of Novgorod to Moscow.
 - 1547 Muscovy elevated and ruled the land until 1917.
 - 1613 Ivan the Terrible became the first czar.
 - 1613 Michael Romanov became the first Romanov czar.
 - 1703 Peter the Great founded St. Petersburg.
 - 1750 Catherine the Great ruled Russia.
 - 1812 Napoleon forced to retreat from Moscow.
 - 1856 Russia defeated by Ottoman Empire in Crimean War.
 - 1861 Alexander II freed the serfs.
 - 1905 Russia defeated in the Russo-Japanese War.
 - Czar Nicholas II forced to establish a parliament.
 - 1914 Russia defeated in World War I.
 - Belshchikov led Czar Nicholas II, under Romanov czar.
