Rules for Field Experiences

- 1. On grounds you are a representative of the Zoo Academy, the Zoo, Your School, and Yourself**
 - a. No Swearing or inappropriate topics
 - b. While on grounds cell phones should not be visible (unless being used for experiment)
- 2. Avoid any behavior that may negatively impact the experience of guests**
- 3. Dress appropriately for field experiences**
 - a. No such thing as bad weather, just poor preparation
- 4. Bring appropriate materials to maximize time in field**
 - a. Bring only what you need
 - b. Water is always needed!
- 5. ANY experiment involving human subjects must be approved with teacher first**
 - a. Experiments with direct contact with human subjects may be subject to zoo approval
- 6. Field Excursions should have clear-cut goals, objectives, and justifications**
- 7. Don't be afraid to problem solve**
 - a. If something is not working either reformat or try something else – Don't try to force something that is not there
