<u>Directions</u>: Look back to your Forum answers from 1.4 looking at the different scales of place that were discussed. As a reminder, the required characteristics are listed below.

City - Identify 3 defining human characteristics (significant landmarks, cultural traits), and 3 defining physical characteristics (climate, physical traits) of your home city.

State - Identify 3 defining human characteristics (significant landmarks, cultural traits), and 3 defining physical characteristics (climate, physical traits) of your home state.

Country - Identify 3 defining human characteristics (significant landmarks, cultural traits), and 3 defining physical characteristics (climate, physical traits) of your home country.

In ArcGIS map each of the characteristics as map notes. Complete with embedded images and correct placement on the map. Include the characteristics as points in map notes.

In addition to the characteristics above - include one "defining" region at each scale. (Ex. Downtown, "up north," and the "midwest" respectively. Include them as areas in map notes.

Make sure you save frequently.

Once finished make sure you save your map and share it to the organization. Copy and paste the link to your map into the submission form on the course website.
