

Fugitive Slave Law


- Forced the return of runaway slaves to their masters

 What risks would Tubman have faced?




Kansas Nebraska Act

- Presented by Stephen Douglas
- Law that established territories of Kansas and Nebraska
 - Citizens would vote to decide if the territories would be free states or slave states.




Bleeding Kansas

- Northerners encouraged to move to Kansas
- Many pro-slavery advocates "moved" Kansas from neighboring Missouri just to vote
 - Kansas voted as a Slave State
- Free State advocates contested decision
- Led to debate and violence



John Brown



- John Brown attacks US
 Arsenal and tries to
 start slave rebellion
- Brown is captured and executed
