


- Norse (Viking) settlers first to reach North America
- Explored Eastern Canada
 - Set up colony around year 1000





Spanish Background





- Ferdinand and Isabella had recently united Spain and expelled the Moors (reconquista)
- Spain wants in on lucrative spice trade with India
 - Highly competitive economically
 - Source of Nationalism

Christopher Columbus





- 1451 Born in Genoa, Italy
- Self taught navigation and Mapmaking
- Served on a French fishing vessel
- Got Idea to travel west to India
 - Propositioned King of Portugal
 - Begged King and Queen of Spain

Approval


- Given funds for three ships
 - Nina
 - Pinta
 - Santa Maria
- Hired 90 able sailors
- Set out August 3,1492





Landfall






- October 11, 1492
 Landed in Bahamas
- Claimed Land and inhabitants for Spain
- Traveled to Cuba and Hispanola
- Called inhabitants "Indians"

Colonization of Hispaniola



- Expedition in 1493 to expand colony
 - Previous colony found decimated
- Began series of "Conversions"
 - Used inhabitants for labor
 - No gold to be found
 - Estimated 250,000 Arawak at time of arrival
 - 1550 only 500 left
 - 1650 extinct

Saint Augustine, Florida


- Discovered by Ponce De Leon
